A message from Bill DeWitt, Co-Founder and Owner of California Wild Ales

I recently took over the location on Newport Ave that was formerly occupied by Helms and Two Roots. I want to introduce myself and let you know a bit about me, my nano-brewery, and why we chose Ocean Beach. I have lived in OB for the past 12 years. I currently live here with my wife and two young daughters. We love this close-knit and vibrant community. Ocean Beach is a part of who we are.

I started California Wild Ales five years ago, and we are San Diego's only all barrel-aged sour brewery. The idea of California Wild Ales was born in Ocean Beach. Both Zack (my business partner) and I were living in Ocean Beach at the time and couldn't find any barrel-aged sours or wild ales, so we set out to make our own.

A message from the City of San Diego

Beginning January 1, 2021, employees who perform at least two (2) hours of work in one work week within the geographic boundaries of the City of San Diego must be paid wages of not less that \$14.00 per hour for all hours worked.
