Street Fair & Chili Cook-Off and Fireworks Update

March 25, 2021

Dear OBMA Members,

We just wanted to let you all know that the OBMA Board of Directors has cancelled the 2021 OB Street Fair & Chili Cook-Off once again due to the pandemic. Although things are opening up again, it just doesn't leave enough time for us to organize and pay for something as large as our traditional OB Street Fair. We have also cancelled the Fireworks. We waited until the last minute to make these difficult decisions.

INSTEAD OF HAVING OUR TRADITIONAL EVENT, we have opted to have a series of events to "Celebrate the OB Vibe" on Saturday, June 26, 2021. The effort will be very ob-centric to drive business to local merchants and activities while ensuring the health and safety of our community.

The main elements of this concept are:

- ♦ Launching an OB Collaborative Brew
- ♦ Art isans and Makers by the Pier vendor area (pier parking lot)
- ♦ Art isans and Makers in the Park vendor area (grassy area)
- ♦ Community Art in private parking lot
- ♦ Children's Creative Corner in private parking lot
- ♦ Dancing District in private parking lot learn many different dances.
- ♦ 5K Community Walk or Run possibly over multiple days and will be an online sign up.
- ♦ Merchant Sidewalk Sale/displays on Saturday

No streets will be closed down and the event will run from 10am to 6pm. We won't be having outside food booths or a designated beer garden because we want to drive business to our local restaurants and bars. We also won't be having stages and music as we normally would due to the many restrictions. We hope that any venues that normally have music would participate by letting us know who is playing and when.

We also won't be raising money for the 2021 fireworks because we have no idea if we would even have access to the pier and/or if the City would allow large gatherings.

If you would like to be involved in this year's Celebrating the OB Vibe event, please let us know how you would like to participate – a special feature at your business, sidewalk sale, food and drink specials, etc. We also have lots of volunteer positions available if you would like to help out.

Again, we believe this is our best opportunity to have something uniquely OB on our regular event day and we think we can have a fun day for people to enjoy our community and patronize all our businesses.

As a local business, please help us!

Now that it is spring again, let's all do some spring cleaning in the commercial district. Work to eradicate graffiti in the commercial areas. Many of the trash receptacles in the alleys are covered in graffiti. Please call your trash removal operator and ask them to replace your dumpster if it has become unsightly. It is their responsibility.

- Remove weeds growing out of the cracks in the sidewalk or alley which are often messy looking and attract litter. Cleaning those weeds up would really help the neighborhood.
- Keep your front windows and doors clean. It's good hygiene and helps put your best foot forward.
- Change out your window displays as frequently as you can. Good lighting is invaluable when displaying your wares.
- Scrub/clean your awning (if you have one) so it looks fresh and inviting.
- Sweep the entrance to your business daily so that customers don't track dirt into your business.

Letter of Agency

LOA's – SDPD needs you to fill out your LOA so they can walk onto your property to address any situation that might be happening. A Letter of Agency (LOA) is a form property owners can fill out that allows the San Diego Police Department to enforce all laws on private property without the owner having to be present to press charges. LOA's must be renewed annually. A copy of an LOA can be accessed at: www.sandiego.gov/police/forms. OBMA will be happy to help you complete this form submit it to SDPD.

Around Town

Is there anything new with the proposed Sidewalk Vending Ordinance?

We are hopeful that the San Diego City Council will follow through and finally pass a reasonable Sidewalk Vending Ordinance that can preserve our park at the foot of Newport for the enjoyment and use of our residents and visitors so that they can access the beach area. We will continue to monitor the situation and participate in finding a solution. The OB Town Council and OB Planning Board are in complete agreement with the OBMA that the San Diego City Council must pass a fair and reasonable Sidewalk Vending Ordinance that doesn't cause our community to lose its park at the foot of Newport Ave. Parks and their grassy areas were never meant to have constant and often daily overuse by a handful of vendors.

We know that this has been a huge issue for so many of our members and we join you in that frustration.
