

A message from The City of San Diego



Citizens,

I have received numerous inquiries regarding our Dispatch / Communications Department regarding how many calls they receive and sometimes why the wait may be longer then in the past. I wanted to take a moment of your time and share with you some of recent call statistics and compare them with a few years ago.

In June 2018: 102,000 total calls into our Communication Center

In June 2021: 125,000 total calls into our Communication Center (a 23,000 increase in calls)

SDPD now averages just under 1.4 million calls per year!

The current average wait time on the Non-Emergency line is 270 seconds or 4 ½ minutes. This is the average so when we have many people calling dispatch the wait time will increase during busier times of the day or during a major incident.

For the past 3 months below I have pasted the stats, which are also posted on the Police Website under "911 Reports":
