

UPDATE ON VEHICLE HABITATION ORDINANCE

A new vehicle habitation ordinance was passed by City Council on May 14th. The new ordinance restricts vehicle habitation from 9am-6pm on City streets and in and non-designated parking lots, AND restricts habitation at any time within 500 feet of residences or schools. After a 30-day educational period, enforcement will begin. To report illegal vehicle habitation, please call 619-531-2000 or use the Get it Done app.








OCEAN BEACH FEATURED IN NATIONAL PUBLICATION




Kids Fun Zone - Tons of fun for kids next to US Bank. Lots of new rides, games and slides.
